St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church uses the Policy Based Governance model. The Leadership Board is composed of nine members, including 4 officer positions (President-male only, Vice President-male only, Secretary, Treasurer) and 5 at-large voting members. The term of office shall be three years for the first term, with eligibility for reelection for an additional three year term.

Qualifications:

- Must be a non-staff, voting member committed to the Great Commandment and the Great Commission
- Must be committed to ongoing discipleship
- Must evidence critical reflection
- Must be trusted by the congregation
- Must be committed to the mission of the congregation
- Must sign and adhere to the Leadership Covenant, which states the expectations of lay leaders as established by the Leadership Board (attached)
- Must complete Leadership Board candidate training
